Winsford High Street Community Primary with Artist **Laura-Kate Draws**

Laura-Kate Draws and Year 3 pupils created drawings, paintings, typography, and patterns celebrating Winsford's architecture and green spaces; the artworks will feature in a new Town Centre subway installation.

Oaklands School with Artist **David Bixter**

Inspired by archive photos of Winsford's salt mines and miners' tools. Year 9 Students created soundboxes using recycled materials, and created improvised soundscapes, rhythms and melodies.

Cine Window Winsford Film Club & The Junction Club, provided by Winsford Youth & Community Forum with Filmmaker **Joe Edwards**

Joe worked with young people to co-create a new film that explores and celebrates the places and spaces of Winsford.

Darnhall Community Primary School, New Images & Home-Education group

with Artist **Mark Haig Gizmobots**

Using found and recycled materials, Mark worked with local children and young people to build four robots striding through the town centre.

Over St. John's C.E. Primary School with Artist **Caroline Daly**

Inspired by their hopes for the future, Caroline and the pupils imagined a rocket landing in Winsford, transporting our family of robots to the town. Their designs for the rocket explore the sights, sounds, smells and tastes of an eco-friendly future town.

Willow Wood Community Primary School with Artist **Neuza Morais**

Inspired by the transformational effects of colour and storytelling, Neuza and the pupils have co-created an installation that will drench the entrance to the shopping centre with vibrant colour.

St Chad's CE Primary School with Artist **Lucy Niemczyk**

Lucy and the pupils recreated stories from Winsford's past, present, and imagined future using shadow puppetry. The stories inspired a sculptural installation in Winsford Cross Shopping Centre and a film of the pupils' shadow puppet performance.
